On behalf of the Hockey Saskatchewan Board of Directors, I would like to advise Minor Hockey Associations within Zone Four (4) that Hockey Saskatchewan will be accepting bids to host the 2025 Hockey Day in Saskatchewan from January 17-19, 2025.

Hockey Day in Saskatchewan was recently held in Kinistino and the host committee has raised over \$113,000 to date. Altogether, Hockey Day in Saskatchewan has raised over \$1.4 million in 16 different communities since its inception in 2008.

The following criteria will be used to select a community to serve as the host for the 2025 event:

- The Minor Hockey Association is a member in good standing with Hockey • Saskatchewan.
- A detailed Host Committee structure for the event is in place.
- A detailed agenda for a weekend of activities is included (see attached suggested agenda/activities for the event).
- If possible, all teams within Minor Hockey have an opportunity to be involved.
- The community has an action plan to build a new arena or renovate its existing arena. •
- A proposed budget for the weekend.
- A local promotional plan. •

Hockey Saskatchewan will provide the following assistance to the host community:

- \$5,000 Hosting Grant
- Local Poster Campaign promoting the host community
- Silent auction items
- Guest speaker or assist in obtaining a guest speaker
- Securing teams for hockey games
- Assistance with printed materials such as programs and tickets

Tips from the Host Committee;

- Begin organizing at least six (6) months in advance.
- Composition of a Host Committee:
 - Minor Hockey Executive
 - One (1) parent from each Minor Team
 - o Representative from Town/Village and/or Arena
 - Representative from Junior or Senior Hockey Team (If applicable)
 - Representative from Hockey Saskatchewan (assigned)
- Create Committees for the Following Activities:
 - Banquet (Caterers; hall; tickets; decorations; set-up and take-down; Master of Ceremonies)
 - Silent Auction (gather items for auction; prepare auction sheets; arrange for credit card machine; fax receipts; "pick-of-the-litter" draw)
 - Raffle Table (Have one or two big-ticket items donated for a raffle (Unity 70 cc Quad and Gas BBQ); get donated early to get tickets sold early in hockey season with a final draw during the weekend.
 - Advertising/Social Media person (Program; Placemats for Banquet; Newspapers; Radio – fax weekend schedule of events to local newspapers and radio – Hockey Saskatchewan will assist provincially and on its website.)
 - Secretary (To keep notes/minutes on Committee meetings; reports; agendas; keep everyone updated with emails)
 - Treasurer (Can be the Minor Hockey Treasurer; have floats available; receive and deposit all money; pay invoices; produce final financial statement)
 - Additional Fundraisers for the Weekend (Pancake Breakfast have product donated; Online 50/50 – requires SLGA licence #, Celebrity Hockey Game; Cabaret; Chili & Bun Dinner; Hamburger Soup Dinner; Prize/Raffle Table – donated prizes)
 - Additional Activities (Outdoor Rink; Horse Hay Rides; Hot Dog Roast; Road Hockey Tournament)
 - Arena Canteen/Booth (Ensure they have extra supplies on hand for the weekend)
